The Magical, Musical, Mystery Show 2023 Performer Requirements Form

By enrolling in this concert and signing this form, you are agreeing to the following performer requirements.

- 1. I will attend both mandatory rehearsals on March 25, 2023, and April 1, 2023, at the Lawrence Arts Center as well as the concert on April 1, 2023. The rehearsals and concert will take precedence over and above other activities. I understand that I am only required to attend the part of the rehearsal involving my pieces. The time for my rehearsals and concerts will be announced after February 15.
- 2. I will completely prepare my respective concert repertoire and practice with my duet partner, according to a schedule agreed to by my teacher and myself. If my repertoire is not prepared by March 25, 2023, I may be disqualified from the performance.
- 3. I agree to be dressed in concert attire on April 1, 2023. Concert attire is black bottoms and plain white tops (no lettering) and dress shoes. Black dresses or skirts are acceptable. The dress or skirt length must fall below the knees. Please confirm with your teacher what you plan to wear.
- 4. I will not wear dangling jewelry, rings, bright nail polish or anything else that may cause damage to pianos or detract from the performance. I will use only the pencils provided at rehearsals (not pens or markers). I understand that these pianos are donated for this event and will do everything in my ability to preserve their value.
- 5. I will not bring gum, food, or drink into the Lawrence Arts Center auditorium or on the stage. Drinking fountain and bathroom breaks during rehearsals will be allowed.
- 6. I understand that concert etiquette requires me to stay for the concert in its entirety.
- 7. I will not use photocopied music at rehearsals or for the concert.
- 8. I will number all the measures in my music scores. Ask your teacher to help you do this.
- 9. I will respect the performance of others by turning off my cell phone for the concert. NOTE: Parents may video students from their auditorium seats. Please silence the ringtones.
- 10. I, the performer, am completely and solely responsible for ensuring that I notice and follow my stage call to join with my repertoire group.
- 11. I agree to grant LAMTA (Lawrence Accredited Music Teachers Association) and the Lawrence Arts Center the right to use photographs or video taken at rehearsals or the concert for publicity purposes in print, broadcast or online media without including identifying information unless I provide a written exclusion request.
- 12. I understand that my failure to follow any of the above rules will cause my performance and enrollment to be rejected for future Multi-Piano Concerts.
